Unemployment Benefits Eligibility

The state of Louisiana has implemented new measures concerning the special circumstance of COVID-19 as it relates to unemployment insurance. If your hours have been reduced due to COVID-19 or you are unable to work remotely due to the nature of your position, you may be eligible for unemployment insurance. Please note these considerations do not apply to student employees who are working remotely or working on premise and continue to be paid. **Ready Prep Teach**

Hiring freeze's impact on postdoc and grad student positions

Teaching and research are mission critical elements of Tulane University. If research can be done within the guidelines of the university, graduate RAs can be hired to work on research projects. With many of our labs working on research directly applicable to the current situation, their work may be even more important than normal. This advice applies to postdoctoral fellows as well. As is standard procedure, all positions must be approved by the dean of the relevant school.
