  - 2. Approval of January Minutes, motioned by B. McFadden, seconded by G. Morris
  - 3. Grad Council Meeting Dates for Spring 2024
    - a. March 20

    - d. Program proposals and major changes need to be submitted to OGPS by the first Wednesday of the month
  - 4. Announcements
    - a. April 15<sup>th</sup> Resolution we're a part of the resolution, put out by the Council of Graduate Schools
    - b. PhD reviews Cell Biology, Ecology and Evolutionary Biology, Neuroscience, Psychology
    - c. Allowable overlap of credits in joint degree programs only 25% of credits can overlap
    - d. 4+1 programs and credits only six credits can count for both degrees. Student can earn another 6 hours beyond what is required for their undergraduate degree which can be applied to their graduate degree
  - 5. Revisions to the Unified Graduate Honor Code Vote
    - a. Some modifications to make sure that the code reflects a broader set of possibilities for professional students as well as research-based graduate students
    - b. Current proposal for the panel is 3 students and 2 faculty. Many of our peers have a faculty majority whereas we have a student majority.
      - i. Students are often more stringent. This panel is a panel of students' peers, and the honor is something that peers hold each other to, versus a monolithic entity that is holding power
      - ii. The final decision is made by the dean on the recommendation of the honor board
    - c. Motion passed, 9 in favor, 1 opposed
  - 6. Freeman School of Business proposal to reduce credit hours of PMBA Vote
    - a. Motion passed, all in favor
  - 7. New business
    - a. Does anything change about how we offer SREB fellowships given the changes from SCOTUS?
